**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF OAKDALE CITY COUNCIL  
AUTHORIZING ADOPTION OF THE OAKDALE 2030 GENERAL PLAN**

**THE CITY OF OAKDALE CITY COUNCIL DOES HEREBY RESOLVE THAT:**

**WHEREAS**, Government Code 65300 et seq. requires cities to adopt a comprehensive, long-term general plan for the physical development of the city and any land outside its boundaries and to update such plan as needed; and,

**WHEREAS**, Government Code Section 65358 allows a city to amend a general plan through its legislative body; and,

**WHEREAS**, in 1994 the City of Oakdale's (the "City") City Council ("City Council") adopted a general plan as the City's primary policy document to direct and guide the physical development of the community throughout a 20-year planning horizon to the year 2015 and beyond with an expected 20-year population forecast of 29,000 persons; and,

**WHEREAS**, in the spring of 2009, the City, began the process of a comprehensive general plan update ("2030 General Plan"), including implementing a public outreach program which included community workshops, joint City and City of Oakdale Planning Commission study sessions to confirm land use and policy direction, landowner outreach by staff, stakeholder interviews, direct media efforts and a dedicated website; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Oakdale Planning Commission ("Planning Commission") implemented a community outreach program to solicit comments on key issues, the community's vision for the future, city wide land use alternatives, areas of desired change, and policy direction; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City provided direction to the City staff to engage a consultant to assist in the preparation of the 2030 General Plan and provide technical assistance to the City staff in the development of the 2030 General Plan; and,

**WHEREAS**, the proposed update to the general plan has been completed pursuant to the said direction, the Planning Commission has reviewed the proposed final 2030 General Plan, technical reports and studies relied upon to develop the 2030 General Plan, the staff report to the Planning Commission including all attachments and exhibits and considered all oral and written testimony received during the public outreach program and the public hearing; and,

**WHEREAS**, the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") requires the City, as lead agency, to prepare an Environmental Impact Report for projects that would or could have one or more significant impacts on the environment; and,

**WHEREAS**, an Environmental Impact Report ("EIR"), State Clearinghouse No. 201108205 has been prepared in conformity with CEQA to evaluate the potential environmental impacts of the 2030 General Plan, the "Project"; and,

**WHEREAS**, by separate resolution, the City Council certified the final Project EIR.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the **CITY COUNCIL** hereby finds, determines and resolves as follows:

1. The above recitals are true and correct and reflect the independent judgment of the City Council.
2. The City Council has been presented with all of the information described in the recitals and has considered this information prior to adopting this resolution.
3. That pursuant to CEQA), the City Council has reviewed and certified the Project EIR prior to making the determinations contained herein.
4. The 2030 General Plan will not be detrimental to the health, safety, or general welfare or injurious to properties within the City.
5. The 2030 General Plan provides a vision for the logical growth and development of the City consistent with its constraints.
6. The 2030 General Plan will establish land use densities and usage that is in character with the City's location, access, and constraints. It presents a pragmatic approach for making specific land use and development decisions that are consistent with the City's physical, economic, social and environmental objectives.
7. The 2030 General Plan consists of a statement of development policies, diagrams and text setting forth objectives, principles, standards, and plan proposals for the future growth and revitalization of the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the **CITY COUNCIL** does hereby take the following actions:

1. Adopt the findings made by the City Council in this resolution.
2. Adopt the 2030 General Plan.
