NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Stanislaus Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) will hold a public hearing on **Wednesday, May 26, 2021**, at a meeting starting at 6:00 P.M. in the Joint Chambers, Basement Level, Tenth Street Place, 1010 10th Street, Modesto, California, to consider the following:

LAFCO APPLICATION NO. 2021-03 – NORMA WAY CHANGE OF ORGANIZATION TO COUNTY SERVICE AREA 26 (KEYES) Stanislaus County has requested to annex approximately 9.77 acres into County Service Area (CSA) 26 – Keyes located between Norma Way and Nunes Road, west of Washington Road in the Keyes area. The annexation is intended to provide services such as maintenance of storm drain infrastructure, masonry walls, sidewalks, parks and streetscape. APN 045-071-006. (See attached map for further details.)

Our records indicate that you are a landowner or registered voter either within the annexation area, within 300 feet of the proposal area, or other interested party. This notice is intended to inform you of the proposal and the ability to provide your comments at or prior to Stanislaus LAFCO's public hearing. Please be further advised that there is potential for the extension or continuation of a previously authorized charge, fee, assessment, or tax by Stanislaus County in the annexation area.

The proposal is considered exempt for purposes of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to §15061(b)(3) which exempts the project though the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. It has been determined with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment; the activity is not subject to CEQA.
